Author *Charlie Sellens* will be focusing on his book *2 Years, 2 Shellbacks*. He will have two montages of pictures of his two years as a Peace Corp Volunteer in the Solomon Islands and display some artifacts that are identified in *2 Years, 2 Shellbacks*.

Cynthia Efken, a longarm quilter, will display and sell quilts she has made and show samples of her quilting. (Also May 3, May 4 and May 5.)

Meet Photographer *Julie Ireland* who focuses her camera on the beauty of nature. Her photo-art pictures are not retouched or photoshopped. Available as notecards and on canvas.

Meet author *Mary Kay Schippers*, who will be signing her popular *Life On the Farm* books.

Debbie Evert, *Wash-N-Well Soaps* creates her homemade soap in a wide variety of unique Kansas designs. Debbie will display samples of the various stages of making her soap.

Judy Wahaus makes her variety of jewelry from antique and new buttons. She will be sharing literature and talking about the source of her buttons. (Also May 5)

Artist *Randy Clark* will be sharing his techniques for creating abstract acrylic paintings without using paint brushes while creating new images.

Artist *Margaret Klassen* will be on hand to discuss her hand-painted porcelain pieces.

Photographer, *Dale Cole* will be discussing his book and the background stories of his various photos on display.

MKC Kitchen's, *Denee Cupp*, will be sampling *Everything Sauce* and *MKC's Rub* created in honor of their daughter.

Sonja Miller will use molds, greenware and paint to demonstrate the various steps, including cleaning, fixing, and glazing, that are necessary to create her ever popular ceramic *Sunflower Dinnerware* and serving pieces.

Meet *The Jelly Lady, Judy Gutzmer*, who will be giving samples of a variety of her homemade jellies.
